We are setting up a Book Review, backed by a distribution service. We aim to make better known and available books and pamphlets which we feel are not getting around, for a variety of reasons, as widely as they should be. One reason is that, even if people have come across a title, the significance of the book's contents is not always clear. Or, the publishers are small movement publishers who are having difficulty distributing their material as widely as they'd like. A substantial proportion of the books and pamphlets will be from abroad (largely from North America), and will be less well known for that reason.

We are political publishers, and we see the Book Review and Book Service as an extension of this function. The selection of books and pamphlets together with the accompanying Review will—broadly—express our politics. We want to help make known and available literature which we feel is particularly important and relevant, so our choice of items will necessarily be very selective. The Review will contain not blurbs but serious reviews.

Reviewers for the first issue include Priscilla Allen, Huw Beynon, Suzie Fleming, Darcus Howe, Selma James, Althea Jones, Jeremy Mulford, Sheila Mullen and Esther Ronay. Among the books and pamphlets reviewed in the first issue are *State Capitalism and World Revolution* by C.L.R. James, *From Feminism to Liberation* edited by H. Altbach, and *From Sundown to Sunup: the Making of the Black Community* by George Rawick. Each issue of the Review will contain reviews of 15 to 20 items that we are distributing. Our distribution list will thus be built up from one issue of the Review to the next. Successive issues of the Review will list what has already been reviewed, and in which issue, so that readers can order appropriate back numbers of the Review if they wish.

The distribution service is intended primarily as a mail order service for individuals. Individuals subscribing to the Book Review will get first option on our stocks. We hope to be able to deal with bookshop orders after that for books and pamphlets from abroad; but we would refer bookshop orders for British publications direct to the publishers.

The Book Review will be published five times a year—in April, June, September, November and February. An annual subscription costs 80p. Single copies cost 20p post free. 




