Dear Harvey Flock,

I reveived your letter of August 2I. Silvia Federivi with whom I am continually in contact just spent some time in Italy with me and Selma James that was here also. We had a discussion a propos of the article of Carol Lopate and we made a reply known that is min my point of view excellent.

I think that at the present moment Silvia will have already sent to you this reply and consequently the problem you are posing in your letter, about my specific position on that is directly solved. I will be very glad also to receive as soon as possible the number of Liberation contai-

ning the publication of that reply.

The perspective of "wage for housework" is developing of course in many materials coming out of the feminist movement in Italy and in Great Britain as well (but as I know in the U.S. and in Canada also especially during the last two years). For the Italian materials there is a document that the feminist group of Padova whith whom I am working is going to publish. As soon as it will be in the definitive form Silvia Federici will have it and will know also who is going to translate it. There are others documents also but not yet translated in English. May be also that in some months someone will be incharged of translating my article "Riproduzione e emigrazione "published in Italy in the book" L'operaio multinazionale ", Feltrinelli ,74 and that is always in the same perspective. Silvia Federici will know also about that.

But beeing this perspective developed in accordance withe ours sisters of the Power of Women Collective in London, I think the best would be, for having in a quick time the materials you are interested in, to write directly to that Collective C/O Selma James, 20 Staverton Road, London, N. W. 2. Not just by accident Selma is coauthor with me of "Power of women and the subversion of the community", and we wrote togheter also the first article of the book that is "Women and the subversion of the community".
